Subject: Revision of Traffic Control Procedures for Soils Removed during Interim Source Removal Action (ISRA),
California Water Code Section 13304 ISRA Order (NPDES No. CA0001309, CI No. 6027, SCP NO. 1111, Site ID No. 2040109)

Dear Mr. Unger:

The Boeing Company, on behalf of Boeing and NASA, is performing soil removal activities at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (Santa Susana Site) in the Outfall 009 watershed as part of the Interim Source Removal Action (ISRA) program. Offsite disposal of the soil has been conducted according to the 2010 ISRA Transportation Plan submitted to the RWQCB on May 28, 2010, and approved by the RWQCB in a letter dated June 30, 2010. The Transportation Plan (Section 5) currently states trucks leaving the Santa Susana Site will be staggered at a minimum of 15 minute intervals between 7 a.m. to 9 a.m., and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m., and at 10 minute intervals during other time periods. Boeing is providing this letter to document the plan to revise the truck interval to a minimum of 5 minutes. This revised truck interval is needed to facilitate on site logistics between the multiple projects being performed at the Santa Susana Site. Boeing is confident a 5 minute interval between trucks will adequately avoid causing traffic problems along Woolsey Canyon Road.
