RELATING TO ARTICLE 20--CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION
(Engineering and Technical Units)~~**

~~It is recognized by the parties that a free flow of information between them is necessary to insure the success of the Ed Wells Partnership. Information which could be disclosed to the Union and to the Union Administrative Staff includes information relating to inventions, products, processes, machinery, apparatus, prices, discounts, costs, business affairs or technical data that the Company considers as confidential. In furtherance of their objective to facilitate full participation of the Union in these programs while recognizing the sensitivity of the Company's confidential information, the parties agree that any such information shall be held in confidence by the Union and the Administrative Staff and shall be used by them solely for purposes of this program. All Union Administrative Staff shall be provided a copy of this Letter of Understanding and advised of their obligations under it.~~
