Mark Kronenberg is vice president, International Business Development for Boeing Defense, Space & Security (BDS). Kronenberg is responsible for leading international market and strategy development and international sales initiatives for BDS and is the interface with the Boeing International team. Kronenberg reports to Chris Raymond, BDS vice president of Business Development, and Shep Hill, Boeing International president.

Before this assignment, Kronenberg led marketing and sales efforts for BDS in the Asia-Pacific region, which represents the fastest growing international market for BDS products and systems. Prior to that, he led the marketing and sales efforts for the Middle East.

Kronenberg began his career at McDonnell Douglas in April 1988 and worked in the Legislative Liaison office until 1993. His areas of responsibility included foreign military sales and international trade. From that assignment, he moved to McDonnell Douglas International Operations and was responsible for government relations activities with a focus on Asia. In 1998, he was named deputy to the vice president for International Operations and managed government relations activities in support of commercial and military programs in the Washington, D.C., office.

Prior to joining McDonnell Douglas, Kronenberg served as legislative director to U.S. Rep. Beverly Byron (D-Md.) from 1983 to 1988, and as a legislative assistant to U.S. Rep. Earl Hutto (D-Fla.) from 1980 to 1983.

Kronenberg graduated from Temple University in Philadelphia in 1978 with a bachelor's degree and received a Master's in Public Administration from American University in Washington, D.C., in 1980.
