Vivek Lall was appointed vice president and country head for Boeing Defense, Space & Security in May 2007. Lall came to this position after serving as managing director of Boeing Commercial Airplanes in India and now offers significant broad India market and customer insights on the emerging needs of the Indian customer.

Lall has held numerous leadership roles in marketing and engineering at Boeing, including manager in the Airplane Performance and Propulsion group. Prior to joining Boeing, he worked for Raytheon and with NASA Ames Research Center in various multidisciplinary engineering fields. He also worked as an adjunct faculty member at Embry-Riddle, McConnell Air Force Base while working at Raytheon. He taught classes in aerodynamics and propulsion for aircraft and spacecraft to U.S. Air Force and Boeing personnel.

Lall earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Carleton University in Canada and a master's degree in aeronautical engineering from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Florida. He also has a Ph.D. in Aerospace Engineering from Wichita State University in Kansas and an MBA from City University in Washington. He has completed management and executive courses at the American Management Association in Washington, D.C., and the Boeing Leadership Center in St. Louis.

Lall has been the recipient of several honors, including the 2008 OCA National Asian Pacific American Corporate Achievement Award. He has also received a gold medal from Cambridge (UK) for his scientific contributions to the field of aerospace, and

has been cited in Who's Who several times. He is in the Sigma Gamma Tau Aerospace Honor Society as well as the Pi Mu Epsilon Mathematics Honor Society. He was president of the Mathematical Association of America and is a member of various engineering and management societies in the United States. He has authored more than 30 articles in various journals. He was also trained as a private pilot at the Phoenix International Flight Training Center.

Lall serves as both chairman of the Defense Steering Committee and co-chairman of the Homeland Security Committee of the American Chamber of Commerce in India. He is also chairman of the Defense Committee of the Association of Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India (ASSOCHAM), and serves as regional president of the Indo American Chamber of Commerce.
