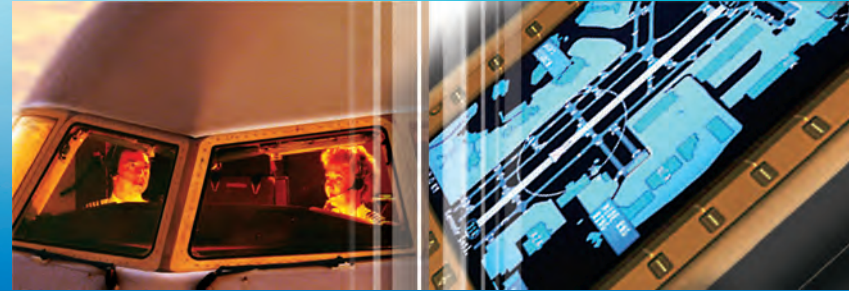

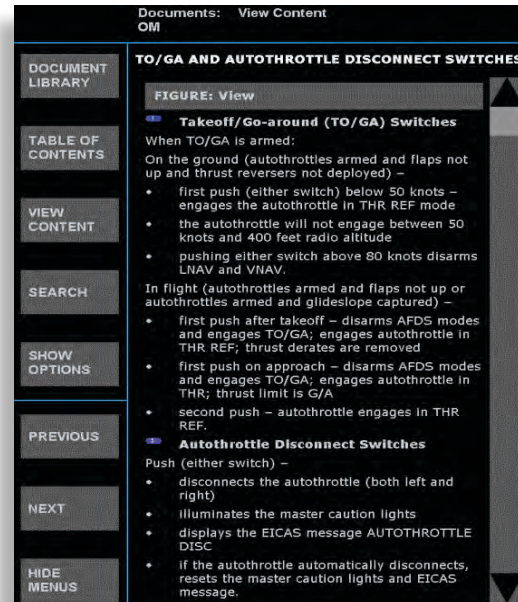

Electronic Documents allow pilots to quickly and easily navigate through flight documents to find the critical information for which they are looking.



## Key features

- Displays most XML formats, PDF, HTML, and scanned documents.
- Provides links between documents and document navigation using hypertext.
- Text search engine for XML.
- Typical documents include entitlement, regulatory, and user defined, such as Flight Crew Operations Manual (FCOM), Quick Reference Handbook (QRH), Flight Crew Training Manual (FCTM), Master Minimum Equipment List (M MEL), Airplane Flight Manual (AFM), Flight Planning and Performance Manual, Airline Policy and Procedures Manual, and so forth.
