Creating Mutually Beneficial Agreements for Licensing Boeing Information

Aircraft owner/operators and third-party service providers

have particular needs for OEM products and services as they support the industry. These products and services may require the use of information that is created during the development and certification of Boeing products. Comments from the industry have helped us to establish a set of Intellectual Property licensing standards that address specific requirements and establish a fair and consistent fee structure for the use of the information developed.



What is Intellectual Property (IP)?

Boeing IP includes proprietary information that is created for the design, development, manufacture, and certification of commercial airplane products and services. In addition to being a *core asset*, this information has inherent value to individuals and organizations that may use it to enhance their business potential.

Who needs a license?

Anyone who intends to produce products or provide services using Boeing Proprietary information needs to obtain a license.

What does a license do for you?

Your license establishes the specific technical information available, how it can be used, and your obligations to protect the information. It also allows direct access to certain state-of-the-art digital data.

Secure and immediate access to Boeing digital information.

An Intellectual Property license allows the licensee the ability to access digital information similar to that which our aircraft owner/operators rely upon.

- Access to maintenance information for all Boeing airframes.
- Access to materials such as detail drawings and services such as Boeing engineering support.
- Fast, efficient delivery of the latest revisions of airplane information.
- Licensing programs to fit the diverse needs of the industry.
- Enhanced information management with reductions in collection, storage, and retrieval by the aircraft owner/operator or third-party service provider.



What kinds of licenses are available?

We have developed a licensing program that facilitates access to information for specific applications, including component repair, airframe repair, and aircraft modification. Types of information licensed may include maintenance and repair publications, installation and assembly drawings, engineering services, and other Boeing IP.



A license may be established by signing the Hardware, Materials, and Services General Terms Agreement (HMSGTA) with a Supplemental License Agreement (SLA) customized to address the specific needs of the licensee. Additionally, the HMSGTA provides a vehicle to procure hardware and services from Boeing.



What are the license fees?

There is no fee for the use of information to support maintenance, repair, and overhaul services. However, a subscription fee to access specific information such as maintenance manuals and installation and assembly drawings may apply. In addition, when detail drawings are used for design and installation of airplane modifications, a one-time fixed fee will be charged. The one-time fixed fee will vary by minor model. Should you require additional information, or consulting services in support of a modification, we will propose a value-based license fee for the use of information to support your modification program. Consulting service fees for engineering services are billed separately.

What are the benefits of the license program?

An IP license provides secure and immediate access to digital information for the worldwide fleet of Boeing aircraft. Additionally, an IP license provides access to services such as Boeing Engineering support. When you partner with Boeing, you partner with the world class leader in aerospace.
