| <p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p> | <p>Yes we accept unsolicited grants; however, we would prefer they contact the GCC focal first prior to application (see last box, below). For 2009 applications that have been discussed and vetted with the GCC focal, an invitation code will be provided.</p> |
| <p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p> | <p>GCC Corporate will provide.</p> |
| <p>Do you accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p> | <p>Under new GCC Process improvement for International and Small US sites, proposal for International schedule is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ June 30 for all grant requests to come in. ▪ July 31 for all payments scheduled and initial reviews by the Regional Staff Analyst ▪ August 15 for all in-country CI's to do their approvals ▪ August 31 for all Corporate approvals to be completed |
| <p>What is the average size of your cash grants?</p> | <p>For 2009, we are allocating approximately \$50K for each country program we are supporting.</p> |
| <p>Which of the five Boeing focus areas does your site support? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p> | <p>We support all Boeing focus areas; however, our main priority is on Health and Human Services.</p> |
| <p>Does your local grantmaking concentrate on specific issues within the focus areas? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p> | <p>Examples of HHS programs that we are funding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Programs that will foster social and economic independence through partnership and collaboration, including job training ▪ Programs that can educate and create awareness in basic health care and nutrition ▪ Capacity building that will enhance current and develop new initiatives that suit the local community and can be used or adopted to other communities with similar situations |
| <p>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</p> | <p>Yes we do accept requests for in-kind donations. Generally we would donate surplus computers. Please Note: Only requests for US in-kind donations are currently available on CyberGrants. International / Non-US in-kind donations are not yet available in CyberGrants.</p> |
| <p>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (Corporate Cash Grants, Employees Community Fund (ECF), Business Sponsorships, Employee Volunteers, etc.)</p> | <p>You may apply for multiple Boeing resources.</p> <p>Request for <i>Corporate Grants</i> can be done ONLY through online submission via Boeing external website link: http://www.boeing.com/companyoffices/aboutus/community/apply_corp_grant.html. Applicants are advised to read and understand Eligibility/Exclusions prior to submission.</p> <p><i>Employees Community Fund</i> is primarily a US program at this time.</p> <p><i>Business Related Donations</i> and <i>Sponsorships</i> are handled differently than the Corporate</p> |
