

## LOCAL CORPORATE GRANT-MAKING GUIDELINES: (SOUTHEAST ASIA)

<p><b>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</b></p>	<p>Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry (LOI) is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click <a href="#">here</a> to obtain the LOI document.</p>
<p><b>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</b></p>	<p>Prior to obtaining the invitation code, organizations must submit their LOI online. The LOI will be reviewed to ensure the project is aligned with Boeing Focus Areas. Organizations that meet the guideline will be given an invitation code to proceed. Unsuccessful organizations will be given a letter of decline</p>
<p><b>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</b></p>	<p>Our schedule for 2012 is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May 5th – LOIs submitted by non-profit organizations</li> <li>• June 29<sup>th</sup> – All grant applications submitted by non-profit organizations</li> <li>• July 1 – August 31<sup>st</sup> : Grants review and approval process</li> <li>• Sept 14<sup>th</sup> – All international grants approved by GCC Corporate</li> </ul>
<p><b>Which of the five Boeing focus areas does your site support? <a href="#">Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</a></b></p>	<p>We support all Boeing focus areas; however, <b>our main priorities</b> are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Health and Human Services</li> <li>• Education</li> <li>• Environment</li> </ul>
<p><b>Does your local grant making concentrate on specific issues within the standard Boeing focus areas? <a href="#">Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</a></b></p>	<p>On Health and Human Services, we are looking for:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Programs that will foster social and economic independence through partnership and collaboration, including job training</li> <li>• Programs that can educate and create awareness in basic health care and nutrition</li> <li>• Capacity building that will enhance current and develop new initiatives that suit the local community and can be used or adopted to other communities with similar situations</li> </ul> <p>On Education, we are looking for:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Projects that can promote the development of quality learning in the areas of math, science and literacy necessary for future success in the workforce and in life.</li> </ul> <p>On Environment, we will support programs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To reduce the deforestation.</li> <li>• Support program that build awareness on good sanitation and clean water.</li> <li>• Support programs that can help to contribute cost recovery and avoid wasting water</li> </ul>
<p><b>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</b></p>	<p>Yes we do accept requests for in-kind donations. Generally we would donate surplus computers. <b>Please Note: Only requests for US in-kind donations are currently available on Cybergrants. International / Non-US in-kind donations will have to go through regional Community Investor.</b></p>
<p><b>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (i.e., Corporate cash grants, Employee Community Fund (ECF), business</b></p>	<p>Absolutely. You may apply for multiple Boeing resources.</p> <p>Request for <i>Corporate Grants</i> can be done ONLY through online submission via Boeing external</p>

<p><b>sponsorships and in-kind resources?</b></p>	<p>website link: <a href="#">Request for Corporate Grants</a>. Applicants are advised to read and understand Eligibility/Exclusions prior to submission.</p> <p><i>Employees Community Fund</i> is primarily a US program at this time.</p> <p><i>Business Related Donations and Sponsorships</i> are handled differently than the Corporate grant. For more information: <a href="#">Business Related Donations and Sponsorships</a></p> <p><i>Employee Volunteers</i>. Off hour volunteerism in the community is encouraged by Boeing; however, this is probably not as popular in this region due to the small presence of Boeing employees compared to Europe or US.</p>
<p><b>May I request employee volunteer support whether or not I request a cash grant?</b></p>	<p>Yes, If you have a volunteer need for a specific event or skill that our employee's may have, please contact the local GCC Community Investor at the email below. Please note, it also subject to availability of employee volunteer support</p>
<p><b>How do I submit a request for a Boeing Executive to serve on my organization's board of directors?</b></p>	<p>Please contact the local GCC Community Investor at the below contact information.</p>
<p><b>If I call or email with a general questions, how soon can I expect a response?</b></p>	<p>You can expect a reply from a phone message within one week. Email responses are typically responded to <a href="#">within 72 hours</a>. Your patience is appreciated.</p>
<p><b>Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?</b></p>	<p>Please refer to the schedule dates stated above. Notifications on grant approval will be sent out September.</p>
