<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Unsolicited grants are not accepted and invitation codes are required.</p>
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>After evaluating your organization and program, your local Community Investor will provide you with an invitation code to be used with our CyberGrants system. Organizations of interest may be asked to fill out a pre-grant survey to assist in evaluation of your request.</p>
<p>Do you accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>Grant proposals in the Arts & Culture focus area are due June 1, 2009. Grant proposals in the Education, Health & Human Services, Civic and Environment focus areas will be accepted on a year- round basis in 2009.</p>
<p>What is the average size of your cash grants?</p>	<p>Our grants vary in size depending on the type of program for which funding is being sought.</p>

Increase professionalism of Pre-K teachers by funding training for early learning centers with Higher Ed partners. We do not provide support for programs that are strictly student-facing. - Collaborative programs that provide innovative job training that leads to employment placement and increased personal income.
- Programs that improve health and human services system capacity building and efficiency, including food, housing and healthcare at the supplier and client levels.
- Social enterprises that serve as a place for on-site job training/business education, which provide disposable products that benefit the community.

Please note for grants of a very high dollar value (over \$100,000) decisions may take longer as executive approvals are also required.
