

LOCAL CORPORATE GRANT-MAKING GUIDELINES: HAWAII

<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click here to obtain the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document: www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi. Before contacting us, please determine that your agency meets the eligibility and exclusions guidelines.</p>
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once you have submitted the LOI electronically to your local GCC Community investor, your request will be reviewed and you will be contacted with an invitation code or to further discuss your grant request.</p>
<p>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>Grant applications are accepted during a specific timeframe each year.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application Period is February 1 – June 30. • Grant Funding Decisions will be made by July 31 <p>IMPORTANT NOTE: Sponsorships for Boeing Hawaii are NOT submitted through a grant application. Please contact your local GCC Community Investor to obtain an invitation code when requesting sponsorship funding from Boeing Hawaii.</p>
<p>Which of the five Boeing focus areas does your site support? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p>	<p>Currently, we accept grant applications primarily focusing on education and the environment in Maui County, including the islands of Lanai and Molokai. Through GCC, we plan to leverage Boeing resources, such as cash and sponsorship grants, as well as employee involvement programs, to maximize our efforts to address community needs in these two focus areas.</p>
<p>Does your local grant making concentrate on specific issues within the standard Boeing focus areas? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p>	<p>With the objective of inspiring environmental citizenship and educating citizens to minimize their impact on the environment, Boeing Hawaii will focus on grants in the Environmental area that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide hands-on experiences which promote environmental stewardship and train the next generation of environmental leaders; 2. Protect and restores Maui County's reefs and the watersheds that filter into them with a focus on storm water management and habitat restoration. <p>With the objective of improving and aligning systems in order to advance students' skills and preparation for further success, Boeing Hawaii will focus on grants in the Education area that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Promote excellent instruction through high-quality teacher professional development and relevant, aligned and internationally benchmarked curriculum. 2. Integrate STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) content and learning practices through partnerships between community organizations and educational systems.
<p>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</p>	<p>Typically, we do not accept requests for in-kind donations.</p>
<p>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (i.e., Corporate cash grants, Employee Community Fund (ECF), business sponsorships and in-kind resources?)</p>	<p>No, because resources are limited, we ask that you decide which support best fits your agency needs and apply for that type of funding.</p>
<p>May I request employee volunteer support whether or not I request a cash grant?</p>	<p>Yes, we have volunteer programs throughout the year. If you have a volunteer need for a specific event, please contact the local GCC Community Investor at the email below.</p>

If I call or email with a general questions, how soon can I expect a response?	You can expect a reply from a phone message within one week. Email responses are typically responded to within 72 hours.
Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?	Typically, notification of funding approval or decline will be sent out within 90 days of application, but no later than September 30 each year.
