<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click here to obtain the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document: www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi</p>
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once the LOI is submitted online, it would be reviewed to ensure that the said project is aligned with the Boeing Focus Areas. Post the completion and approval of the process, the organization will be given the invitation code. Unsuccessful organizations will be given a letter of decline.</p>
<p>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>May 16th – LOIs submitted by non-profit organizations June 30th – All grant applications submitted by non-profit organizations July 15th – Country/regional focals complete their review and approval of all of the grants Aug 31st – Due diligence completed by GCC Corporate Sept 16th – All international grants approved by GCC Corporate</p>
