Apply for a Grant: Macon

Introduction

The Employees Community Fund (ECF) of Macon is part of an international network of Boeing employee-owned and operated nonprofit charitable foundations. The Macon ECF follows the guidelines of the California ECF and funds health & human services, civic & environment, arts, and educational organizations. Agencies must qualify with the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) organization.

Geographical Restrictions

ECF of Macon provides support largely for agencies located in the city of Macon and surrounding communities.

Timeline

Proposals are accepted throughout the year and are considered on a quarterly basis. Decisions are generally made within 90 days of proposal receipt.

Restrictions

The ECF of Macon does not fund:

- Political organizations or programs
- Fraternal, sectarian, social, religious, auxiliaries or similar organizations
- Youth sports organizations and educational institutions, except those dedicated solely to the handicapped
- Tax-supported endeavors, except joint government and private enterprise projects
- Private foundations
- Trips, tours, or fundraising sponsorship (of individuals)
- Fundraising events, including courtesy advertising, conferences or dinner tickets
- Service club activities
- Scholarships
- Endowments

Instructions for Applying for ECF Funding

Agencies are only allowed to submit one application per calendar year. A grant does not necessarily indicate that continued support will be available.

Agencies must apply using Boeing's online grant application. Invitation codes are not required. Hardcopy applications will not be accepted. The link to the on-line application is below.
