<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry (LOI) is required in order to obtain an invitation code. <p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once you have submitted the LOI electronically to your local GCC Community Investor, your request will be reviewed and you will be contacted with an invitation code or to further discuss your grant request. An invitation code will only be obtained once your Letter of Inquiry has been approved.</p>										
<p>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>We recommend proposals be submitted between January to March of each year. Letter of Inquiries filled should be submitted no later than March and online application is due in June. Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?	Notifications of funding approval or decline are sent out between July 1 and September 30 each year.
