<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations are unable to submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click here to obtain the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi</p>								
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once you have submitted the LOI electronically to your local GCC Community Investor, your request will be reviewed and you will be contacted with an invitation code or to further discuss your grant request.</p>

<p>Does your local grant making concentrate on specific issues within the standard Boeing focus areas? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p>	<p>We work within the five enterprise-wide focus area objectives to develop a site-specific plan tailored to the needs of the Albuquerque Region.</p>								
<p>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</p>	<p>We do not accept requests for in-kind donations.</p>								
<p>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (i.e., Corporate cash grants, Employee Community Fund (ECF), business sponsorships and in-kind resources?)</p>	<p>No, because resources are limited, we ask that you decide which support best fits your agency needs and apply for that type of funding.</p>								
<p>May I request employee volunteer support whether or not I request a cash grant?</p>	<p>No, we do not offer in-kind volunteer support.</p>								
<p>How do I submit a request for a Boeing Executive to serve on my organization's board of directors?</p>	<p>We typically do not accept requests for Boeing executives to serve on boards.</p>								
<p>If I call or email with a general questions, how soon can I expect a response?</p>	<p>You can expect a reply from a phone message within one week. Email responses are typically responded to within 72 hours. Your patience is appreciated.</p>								
<p>Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?</p>	<p>Notifications of funding approval or decline are sent out between July 1 and September 30 each year.</p>
