Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?	Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code.

Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?	The proposal acceptance period is January – April.

Does your local grant making concentrate on specific issues within the standard Boeing focus areas? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives	<p>Primary & Secondary: professional development for teachers.</p> <p>Arts & Culture: programs that engage people to become lifelong arts and cultural participants, patrons or practitioners.</p> <p>Health & Human Services: Community-based programs that address disparities in healthcare</p>
