

LOCAL CORPORATE GRANT-MAKING GUIDELINES: MISSOURI

<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations are unable to submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click here to obtain the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi</p>
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once you have submitted the LOI electronically to your local GCC Community Investor, your request will be reviewed and you will be contacted with an invitation code or to further discuss your grant request.</p>
<p>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>Grant applications are accepted anytime throughout the year but all funding decisions will be completed by September 30. IMPORTANT NOTE: Sponsorship, business donation or membership requests for Boeing Missouri are NOT submitted through a grant application. Grant requests are evaluated on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alignment with our corporate focus area objectives, company values and core competencies • Clearly defined expected outcomes relative to community needs, that are measurable, scalable, and have a sustainable impact on the community beyond the period of the company's involvement • The extent to which the project or program demonstrates innovation, collaboration, leadership and diversity • The organization's financial viability, programmatic strength, and legal compliance
<p>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</p>	<p>Typically, we do not accept requests for in-kind donations.</p>
<p>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (i.e., Corporate cash grants, Employee Community Fund (ECF), business sponsorships and in-kind resources?)</p>	<p>Yes</p>
<p>May I request employee volunteer support whether or not I request a cash grant?</p>	<p>Yes but most volunteer activities align with the non-profit receiving cash contributions.</p>

Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?	Notifications of funding approval or decline are on an ongoing basis as grants are received and evaluated.
