<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Boeing considers a limited number of grant requests from organizations with operations & programs in the following geographic areas of Texas: Abilene, Corpus Christi, Richardson/Dallas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organizations may not submit a grant request without an invitation code. • A pre-application Letter of Inquiry (LOI) is required in order to obtain an invitation code. • Review the section below on local grant making objectives as well as Boeing's eligibility/exclusions guidelines. • If you feel your program is aligned to the local grant making objectives listed below, please complete the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document at www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi. First time users must create a profile. • All unsolicited grants will be denied.
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>An invitation code is only provided after an LOI is submitted electronically and has received a favorable review. You will be contacted regarding next steps after your LOI is received.</p>
<p>Do you only accept proposals only during specific timeframes or may I apply at anytime?</p>	<p>Grant applications are accepted on the following schedule:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application Period (for all focus areas): February 1 – June 30 • Evaluation of Grant Requests: As submitted from February 1 – June 30 • Grant Funding: Decisions July 1 – August 31 • Grant Awards: September 1 – October 31

<p>Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?</p>	<p>Organizations will be notified if additional information is needed, if a site visit is required and when a final decision is reached. Please do not send unsolicited materials. Your patience is appreciated.</p>
