<p>Are unsolicited grants accepted or do I need an invitation code?</p>	<p>Organizations are unable to submit a grant request without an invitation code. A pre-application Letter of Inquiry is required in order to obtain an invitation code. Click here to obtain the Letter of Inquiry (LOI) document www.cybergrants.com/boeing/loi</p>								
<p>If I need an invitation code, how do I acquire one?</p>	<p>Once you have submitted the LOI electronically to your local GCC Community Investor, your request will be reviewed and you will be contacted with an invitation code or to further discuss your grant request.</p>

<p>Does your local grant making concentrate on specific issues within the standard Boeing focus areas? Boeing: Corporate Focus Areas/Objectives</p>	<p>Arts and Culture focuses on programs that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Invest in artistic projects that support the creation and presentation of risk-taking new works. • Invest in collaborations of artistic or administrative functions between two arts nonprofits <p>Early Learning focuses on programs that enhance parent knowledge and skills around early learning development.</p> <p>Primary and Secondary Education focuses on programs that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strengthen the effectiveness of teachers in math and science. Education funding priority will be given to K-12 Teacher Professional development in the Gresham Barlow School District, Portland Public School District, and the Reynolds School District. <p>Health and Human Services focuses on programs that help people attain a living wage.</p>								

	<p>Environment focuses on programs that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support hands-on environmental education for children. • Support recycling efforts. • Portland-metropolitan area rivers and watersheds that flow in to them. <p>Grant requests are evaluated on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alignment with our corporate focus area objectives, company values and core competencies • Clearly defined expected outcomes relative to community needs, that are measurable, scalable, and have a sustainable impact on the community beyond the period of the company's involvement • The extent to which the project or program demonstrates innovation, collaboration, leadership and diversity • The organization's financial viability, programmatic strength, and legal compliance
<p>Do you accept requests for in-kind donations and if so, what do you generally donate?</p>	<p>Typically, we do not accept requests for in-kind donations.</p>
<p>May I apply for multiple Boeing resources? (i.e., Corporate cash grants, Employee Community Fund (ECF), business sponsorships and in-kind resources?)</p>	<p>No, because resources are limited, we ask that you decide which support best fits your agency needs and apply for that type of funding.</p>
<p>May I request employee volunteer support whether or not I request a cash grant?</p>	<p>Yes, but most volunteer activities must have alignment with corporate focus areas.</p>
<p>How do I submit a request for a Boeing Executive to serve on my organization's board of directors?</p>	<p>Oregon does not accept unsolicited requests for service on non-profit boards.</p>
<p>If I call or email with a general questions, how soon can I expect a response?</p>	<p>You can expect a reply from a phone message or email response within one week. Your patience is appreciated.</p>
<p>Once I submit my grant application when will I hear if it has been approved?</p>	<p>Notifications of funding approval or decline are sent out between July 1 and October 31 each year.</p>
