## Apply for a Grant: Washington, D.C. (National Capital Area)

### Introduction

The Employees Community Fund (ECF) of Washington, D.C. (National Capital Area) is part of an international network of Boeing employee-owned and operated nonprofit charitable foundations that funds primarily health & human services organizations. Agencies must qualify with the Internal Revenue Service as a 501(c)(3) organization.

Grants awarded in the Washington, D.C. (National Capital Area) region have typically ranged from \$10,000 to \$15,000.

### Timeline

Proposals are accepted throughout the year. Decisions are generally made within 120 days of proposal receipt. Agencies will be notified when a decision has been made.

### Restrictions

The ECF of Washington, D.C. (National Capital Area) does not fund:

- Political organizations, programs, or activities
- General budgets of or memberships to fraternal, sectarian, social, religious or similar groups; such organizations may request grants for broadly offered health and human services missions to the community, but ECF will not support activities involving proselytizing.
- Travel expenses or trips
- Courtesy advertising, fundraising events, such as walks, runs, galas, auctions, or sponsorships of conferences or dinners
- Endowments
- School or youth association sports teams
- Requests for contributions to benefit a specific individual

### Instructions for Applying for ECF Funding

An invitation code is required to apply for funding from the ECF of Washington, D.C. (National Capital Area). Invitation codes are given to agencies after preliminary discussion with the ECF focal. Please see the contact information below.
