Come with a purpose

‘ VERY IMPORTANT ’

Some teachers give students assignments for the day (collect certain information, write a report, etc.). This helps the class focus on the exhibits and will help them learn more about the environment.

Make it easy to spot members of your group

‘ VERY IMPORTANT ’

We expect 10,000 to 11,000 students to attend. It’s difficult to spot individual students in a large crowd. Some classrooms wear matching or decorated T-shirts, headbands, name tags, etc. This will help you keep track of your class, and helps us locate lost students and teachers.

Bring a bag ‘ VERY IMPORTANT ’

Many exhibitors give away small items, such as plants, worms, pencils, etc. It’s fun for classes to decorate small or medium-sized shopping bags and bring them to collect things. Bags with handles work best. Ask your favorite store to help you out, or be creative and recycle!

Practice what you learn ‘ VERY IMPORTANT ’

Let’s practice good recycling habits at Earth Day Kansas. Trash containers and volunteers will be on hand to help everyone sort waste as it’s thrown away. Please coach your class to put trash where it belongs.
