GPS IIR-6 Nov. 10, 2000
 A Boeing Delta II 7925-9.5 launch vehicle carrying the U.S. Air Force's GPS IIR-6 satellite lifts off from Space Launch Complex 17, Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, Fla. This was the 33rd launch for the GPS program aboard a Delta rocket and lifted off at 12:14 p.m. EST.



GPS IIR-7 Jan. 30, 2001
 A Boeing Delta II 7925-9.5 launch vehicle lifts off from Space Launch Complex 17, Cape Canaveral Air Force Station, Fla., carrying the GPS IIR-7 spacecraft for the U.S. Air Force Space Command. The rocket lifted off at 2:55 a.m. EST. This was the 34th launch for the GPS program aboard a Delta rocket.
