



# ITALY KC-767 COMPLETES FIRST IN-FLIGHT FUEL TRANSFERS



Two major milestones for the KC-767 Tanker program were recently achieved. On March 5th, the Italy KC-767 met up with a B-52 over Southern California and transferred over 10,000 pounds of fuel to the venerable workhorse. Over 70 boom contacts were made testing the entire range of the boom envelope. The following day, the same tanker met up with an F-15E, and off-loaded over 5,000 pounds of fuel using the advanced boom and remote air refueling vision system.
