Configured Dispatch Deviations Guide (DDG) Service

Configured DDG Service enables operators to take advantage of Boeing technical and publication resources to more efficiently develop, publish, and revise their Minimum Equipment List (MEL).

DDG services are intended to assist airline operations and maintenance organizations develop the required procedures for operating aircraft in the various non-standard configurations. Boeing offers two levels of this enhanced service:

Configured DDG Service

Our Configured DDG Service enables operators to configure the Boeing Master DDG to their specific airplane configuration:

- Reflecting an operator's specific airplane minor model(s), specific airplane configuration(s), and specific optional equipment
- Providing performance data with weight units
- Adding an operator's logo on all pages

Customer Originated Change (COC) Service

COC Service enables operators to customize the Configured DDG to their unique operational requirements:

- Reflecting the actual number of equipment installed/required
- Incorporating Service Bulletins, maintenance and operations policies, and local regulatory agency requirements
