

# ST. LOUIS VETERANS HONOR WALL AUTHORIZATION LETTER

The St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall is located in Veterans Plaza outside Building 100, St. Louis, Missouri. Dedicated November 11, 2005, the Honor Wall is a tribute to all St. Louis Site veteran employees of Boeing/McDonnell Douglas, past and present, for their dedicated service in the United States Armed Forces and employment with our company. It includes St. Louis veteran employee names and their branch of service as identified with this Authorization letter. Each name is displayed with dog-tag shaped plaques, inter-mixed amongst the services, reflecting the diversity of each St. Louis veteran employee.

Participation with the St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall is voluntary. Written permission is required prior to a St. Louis Site veteran employee's name being displayed on the Honor Wall. Completion and return of the below form ensures that the name is placed on the St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall correctly. This is the only form used to collect this type of information and the information provided will be used solely for this purpose.

The St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall, Honor Wall Display Book, and internal Boeing website will display the names of all identified St. Louis Site veterans employed by Boeing/McDonnell Douglas, living or deceased, who meet the above requirements. For those who have passed away, we ask that an immediate relative, such as a spouse or child, sign the form on behalf of the employee, as in, "I, Xxxx Xxxx, on behalf of Xxxx Xxxx ...".

A St. Louis Site veteran employee includes all those who physically worked at the St. Louis regional site. This includes current employees, contract hires, retirees, and previously employed St. Louis Site veteran employees. Veteran employees or requesting relatives of a deceased veteran employee who wish to have their names on the St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall, who meet the above requirements, may complete this form and return it via interoffice mail to **Boeing Veterans Honor Wall, M/C S100-3132**, or mail the completed form to: The Boeing Company; St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall: MC: S100-3132; P.O. Names are updated semi-annually on the internal Boeing website and Honor Wall/Book after receipt and verification of the completed form. To ensure a name submitted was received, persons may request a confirmation by sending an e-mail to **stlveteranstraskforce@boeing.com**. Please include the full veteran employee's name and their branch of service. Those without e-mail may provide their request by standard mail to the above address. Please provide appropriate contact information. All corrections must be completed via e-mail or in writing - please DO NOT re-submit additional forms for the same name if already submitted.
