

ST. LOUIS VETERANS HONOR WALL AUTHORIZATION LETTER

The St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall is located to the left of the main entrance of Building 100, in Veterans Plaza, St. Louis, Missouri. The Honor Wall is a tribute to all St. Louis Site veteran employees of Boeing/McDonnell Douglas, past and present, for their dedicated service in the United States Armed Forces. The Honor Wall was dedicated November 11, 2005. The self-identified names of St. Louis veteran employees, and their branch of service, are displayed on the walls with dog-tag shaped plaques, inter-mixed amongst services, reflecting the diversity of St. Louis veteran employees.

Participation with the St. Louis Veteran Honor Wall is voluntary. Written permission is required prior to a St. Louis Site veteran employee's name being displayed with the Honor Wall. Completion and return of the form below ensures that the name is placed on the St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall correctly. This is the only form used to collect this type of information and the information provided will be used solely for this purpose only.

The St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall, Honor Display Book located in Veterans Plaza, and internal Boeing website will display the names of all St. Louis Site veterans employed by Boeing/McDonnell Douglas, living or deceased, who meet the above requirements. For those who have passed away, we ask that an immediate relative, such as a spouse or child, sign the form on behalf of the employee, as, "I, Xxxxx Xxxxx, on behalf of Xxxxx Xxxxx, give permission to ...".

St. Louis Site veteran employees/retirees who wish to have their names on the St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall, who meet the above requirements, may complete the form below and return it via interoffice mail to **M/C S100-3132**. Retired or previously employed St. Louis Site veteran employees, or requesting relatives of a deceased veteran employee, may mail the completed form to: The Boeing Company; St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall: MC: S100-3132; P.O. Names are updated quarterly on the internal Boeing website, after receipt and verification of the completed form. To ensure a name submitted was received, persons may request a confirmation by sending an email to **stlveteranstraskforce@boeing.com**. Please include the full veteran employee's name and branch of service. People without email may provide your request by standard mail to the above address. Please provide all contact info that we may respond to your request. Please, **DO NOT** re-mail additional forms for the same name if already submitted. All corrections must be completed via email or in writing.
