



St. Louis Veterans Task Force

The St. Louis Veterans Honor Wall is a tribute to all St. Louis site veteran employees of Boeing/McDonnell Douglas, past and present, for their dedicated service in the United States Armed Forces.

The Honor Wall consists of seven-foot-high, circular stainless-steel walls divided into five segments. The names and branches of service of St. Louis Veteran Employees are displayed on dog tag shaped plaques fastened to the wall with rivets, a key component in the construction of our aircraft/products manufactured at the St. Louis site. A fountain centers the memorial, with benches offering reflection and appreciation to the contributions made by our Veteran Employees. Between each of the five walls stands a flagpole for each of the United States branches of military.

The St. Louis Employee Veterans Honor Wall was dedicated at the annual, Veterans Recognition Ceremony, November 11, 2005. All current and former Boeing St. Louis Site employee veterans are eligible to have a plaque with their name and branch of service permanently attached.

Armed Forces & Memorial Day – May

This event honors all U.S. Armed Forces serving throughout the world. National POW/MIA Recognition Day – September

This event honors the service & sacrifices of all U.S. Veterans who have been or currently are Prisoners of War or Missing in Action.

This event recognizes the contributions of the thousands of St. Louis Veteran employees, retirees, customers, friends, and families who have or are serving in the U.S. Armed Forces.



The names of St. Louis veteran employees and their branch of service are displayed on the memorial walls with dog tag shaped plaques. The dog tags are inter-mixed amongst the five branches of service, reflecting the diversity of veteran employees at the St. Louis site.
