## Highly Sensitive Personally Identifiable Information (HSPII) Definition

A nine-digit number issued to U.S. citizens, permanent residents, and temporary (working) residents, primarily for taxation purposes.
Five or more digits of SSN are subject to Social Security Protection laws and Breach Notification laws in the U.S. (California, Indiana, Kansas, Michigan, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, Oklahoma, Virginia) and US Supreme Court Rules of Civil Procedure.
A number associated with an official government document that certifies one's identity and nationality and permits a citizen to travel from one country to another.
A U.S. Uniformed Services Privilege and Identification Card (also known as U.S. military ID, Geneva Conventions Identification Card, or less commonly abbreviated USPIC) is an identity document issued by the United States Department of Defense to identify a person as a member of the Armed Forces or a member's dependent, such as a child or spouse. Any similar identification issued by a foreign military. Geneva Convention cards are also issued to armed services personnel and authorized civilians accompanying them to show that they are entitled to be protected as prisoners of war under both the Hague and Geneva Conventions. Any non-military identification issued by any valid national government agency, US or foreign.
Drivers license issued by individual states
A number on a card issued by U.S. states for identification purposes.
Boeing issued corporate cards, or personal credit card or debit card numbers.
Personal financial account numbers of any type (routing, bank, saving and loan, credit union, etc.) NOTE: This pertains to bank accounts attached to a person's name.
Numbers, PINs, challenge and response pairs, and passwords used to gain access to financial accounts. This information is considered HSPII only when in combination with the account information that it is related to.
Month, day, and year or the ability to derive it from month and day with the age.
The surname of the individual's Mother prior to marriage.
Any information regarding an individual's medical history, mental or physical condition, or medical treatment or diagnosis by a health care professional. This includes individually identifiable information, in electronic or physical form, in possession of or derived from a provider of health care, health care service plan, or contractor regarding a patient's medical history, mental or physical condition, or treatment.
"Individually identifiable" means that the medical information includes or contains any element of personal identifying information sufficient to allow identification of the individual, such as the patient's name, address, electronic mail address, telephone number, or social security number, or other information that, alone or in combination with other publicly available information, reveals the individual's identity.
Includes an individual's health insurance policy number or subscriber identification number, any unique identifier used by a health insurer to identify the individual, or any information in an individual's application and claims history, including any appeals records, and may include other elements.
Measurements of certain human body characteristics that uniquely identify an individual, like genetic information, DNA profiles, etc.
Measurements or technical analysis of human body characteristics or behaviors used by the owner or licensee to authenticate an individual, such as a fingerprint, retina or iris image, or other unique physical representation or digital representation of biometric data.
