### AIRPORT CURFEWS

Voluntary nighttime curfew between 10 pm and 7 am local time. Pilots are strongly encouraged not to fly during these hours. Airport Security monitors all arrivals and departures and provides a listing of aircraft registration numbers to the Noise Abatement Office, which compiles a monthly list to be placed on the airports web site.

PREFERENTIAL RUNWAYS

Established for Runway 5-23 from 10 pm to 7 am local time. Runway 5 is used for departures and Runway 23 is used for landing, winds and air traffic permitting.

ENGINE RUN-UP RESTRICTIONS

Engine Maintenance Run-ups prohibited from 10 PM until 7 AM. Daytime run-ups are restricted to the center of the airport to reduce noise in the residential areas closest to the airport.

Voluntary restraint from operating APUs and GPUs from 10 pm to 7 am local time.

#### STAGE 2 RESTRICTIONS

Stage 1 and 2 jet aircraft (with the exception of Government aircraft and bona fide ambulance flights) are prohibited from operating at the Naples Municipal Airport

Voluntary Curfew from 10:00 pm to 7:00 am local time.

#### Comments
